
IIDA Webinar Going Beyond GREEN

Betty Hase, IIDA, ASID, Herman Miller "Phylogenetic Design: Lessons from Nature" CEU/CES 1 hr.

This presentation is focused on preferred natural habitat research and theories. Clues to look at designing space differently and perhaps from our own inherent knowledge that have been passed along genetically. Phylogenetic Design explains the attributes of a preferred natural habitat and suggests how to interpret those features and implement them in a built environment.
